

## Charged With Redford, Livonia Beatings

### Nab 'Vicious' Pistol Whipper

An armed thug, wearing a woman's stocking over his head with a mad desire to pistol whip his victims and termed by Livonia police as the "most vicious" criminal they have encountered in years, is in custody and charged with assault and intent to rob while armed.

Roger Wannamaker, 23, of Dearborn Township, is in Wayne County Jail after his arrest by Livonia Police Capt. Michael Vorgitch and Detective Jerry Warren along with Dearborn Township authorities.

He was sought after pistol whipping a Livonia woman during an attempted robbery and then charged with the same crime on a Catholic priest in a Redford Township motel

two weeks ago, according to police reports.

Roger was arrested in Dearborn Township after authorities received a tip as to his whereabouts.

Wannamaker, accompanied by Howard McDonald, 35, 5637 Centralia, Dearborn Township, decided to rob Collyer's Market, 27710 Plymouth Road, according to police.

McDonald remained in the getaway car, parked in front of the store, while Wannamaker entered through a rear door. However, he was surprised by Mrs. Geraldine Collyer as he moved into the store.

Wannamaker, it is alleged, ordered Mrs. Collyer to undress but instead she screamed

for help and he immediately started to pistol whip her.

The screams attracted the attention of her husband, Russell, who raced in from the front. In the meantime, the noise was heard by McDonald who started the car and sped away but not before Curtis Collyer, nephew of the owners, jotted down the license number.

Wannamaker took off through the darkness and vanished in the nearby streets before Livonia police arrived.

Shortly afterward, Vorgitch and Warren discovered the car parked at a drive-in at the intersection of Guley and Ford Roads.

When questioned, McDonald denied any knowledge of the incident but was taken to the Livonia Police station and booked for investigation.

Then next morning, Dearborn Township police received the tip that led to the arrest of Wannamaker at a Dearborn Township home.

Wannamaker was identified by Mrs. Collyer in a police lineup as the assailant.

Further investigation brought the Redford Township incident to light where Father Charles Kilgoar, of Grand Rapids, had been severely pistol whipped when he surprised a burglar searching his room.

When questioned, Wannamaker denied any knowledge of the Redford beating but has been tied up with it according to police reports.

The pair was arraigned before Livonia Municipal Judge Robert Lorian and held on bond, Judge Lorian set McDonald's bond at \$10,000 and Wannamaker's at \$6,000. Both were taken to County Jail when they failed to raise the monies.

## Livonia Meeting Launches Petitions On Income Tax

Vigilance Tax Committee of Michigan has approved a statewide petition drive to get citizen support for two propositions which would impose restrictions on tax incomes.

The action was taken in a meeting Saturday in the new Livonia Police Station with Mayor Harvey Moeke as host.

Berkley Mayor George Kuhn, committee chairman, said the group hopes to have 500,000 signatures when it requests the Legislature to act in November.

The Committee will ask legislation to prevent any city, village, township or county from levying an income tax and to a vote of the people without a bar taxing of income of nonresidents.

Royal Oak Mayor William Hayward, chairman of the petition circulating committee, said that if the petitions are filed with at

least 250,000 signatures in November, the Legislature would have 40 days to consider enacting the items itself or could place them and any alternatives deemed necessary in a state referendum next April.
