Three management appointments at Ford Motor Company's Research and Engineering Center were announced by Victor Hopeman, director—Testing Operations Office.

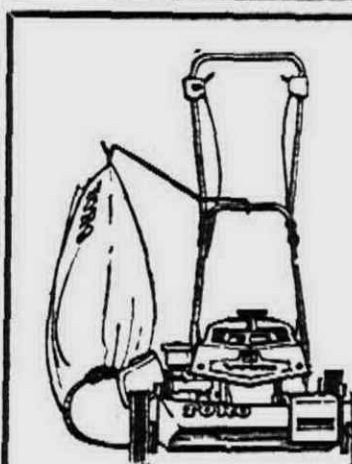
Glenn F. Doyle has been named executive engineer in charge of Ford's three proving grounds at Dearborn and Romeo, Mich., and Kingman, Ariz.

19 Area High School Seniors Win U-M Regents Scholarships

NINETEEN high school seniors from the area are among those from 449 schools receiving 805 Regents-A U-M n i Scholarships to the University of Michigan according to an announcement by Ivan Parker, assistant director of Financial Aids.

More than 2,200 applied for the awards which are made annually. Last year 733 seniors in 416 accredited high schools won scholarships.

This year's group includes eight from Bentley High and six from Franklin in Livonia, four from Plymouth and one from Clarenceville.

The stipends vary according to financial need of the winners, ranging from an honorary \$50 entrance award to a \$560 per year grant. In a number of cases, the scholarship committee also included an offer

of part time employment and long term loans in the financial aid offer.

This package approach tried last year for the first

time is being continued because of its success in assisting students to meet the rising cost of education. Awards continue for the normal

length of each student's degree program if his academic record justifies renewal. Each accredited school is entitled to at least one of the

scholarships if a qualified senior applies. Also, some awards are granted at-large on the basis of state-wide comparison of applicants from participating

schools. There are no limits on the number of applicants from, or awards to, any one school.

In evaluating the applicants, emphasis is on character, citizenship, academic record, financial need, and scores on a competitive test.

Club members who worked on the project gave invaluable assistance to high school officials and the University Scholarship Committee, Parker said.

'Point of Order' Opens April 23 at ACLU Benefit

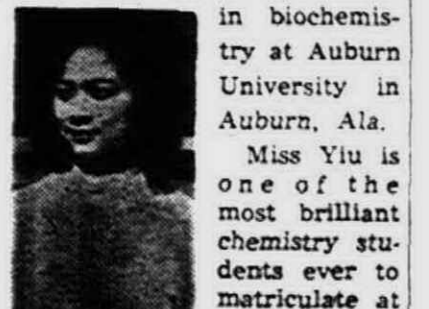



Funk Tells Plans For Tax Sales

County Treasurer Louis H. Funk said Monday that his office has 11,879 parcels of land throughout the County listed to be offered at the Tax Sale beginning May 5, for non-payment of 1961 taxes.

The sale of all of the descriptions would yield a total of \$899,954.24, including all interest and penalty charges through April 30.

Funk also warned Wayne County taxpayers that all 1960 taxes sold at the May, 1963 sale must be redeemed by the end of April to safeguard title to the property.

At the present time, title to 1,839 parcels amounting to \$129,960.12 will go to the State of Michigan effective May 5 unless redeemed prior to that time.

The same deadline is in effect on an additional 2,218 descriptions totalling \$115,222.57 on which tax certificates were issued to professional tax title buyers at the May, 1963 Tax Sale. These buyers are entitled to the issuance of a tax deed upon presentation of their certificate to the Auditor General of the State of Michigan.

Funk urges all taxpayers in the County, owing 1960 and/or 1961 taxes, to pay immediately to protect their property.

Squads start at 11 a.m. on each Saturday and Sunday and continue through 1 p.m.

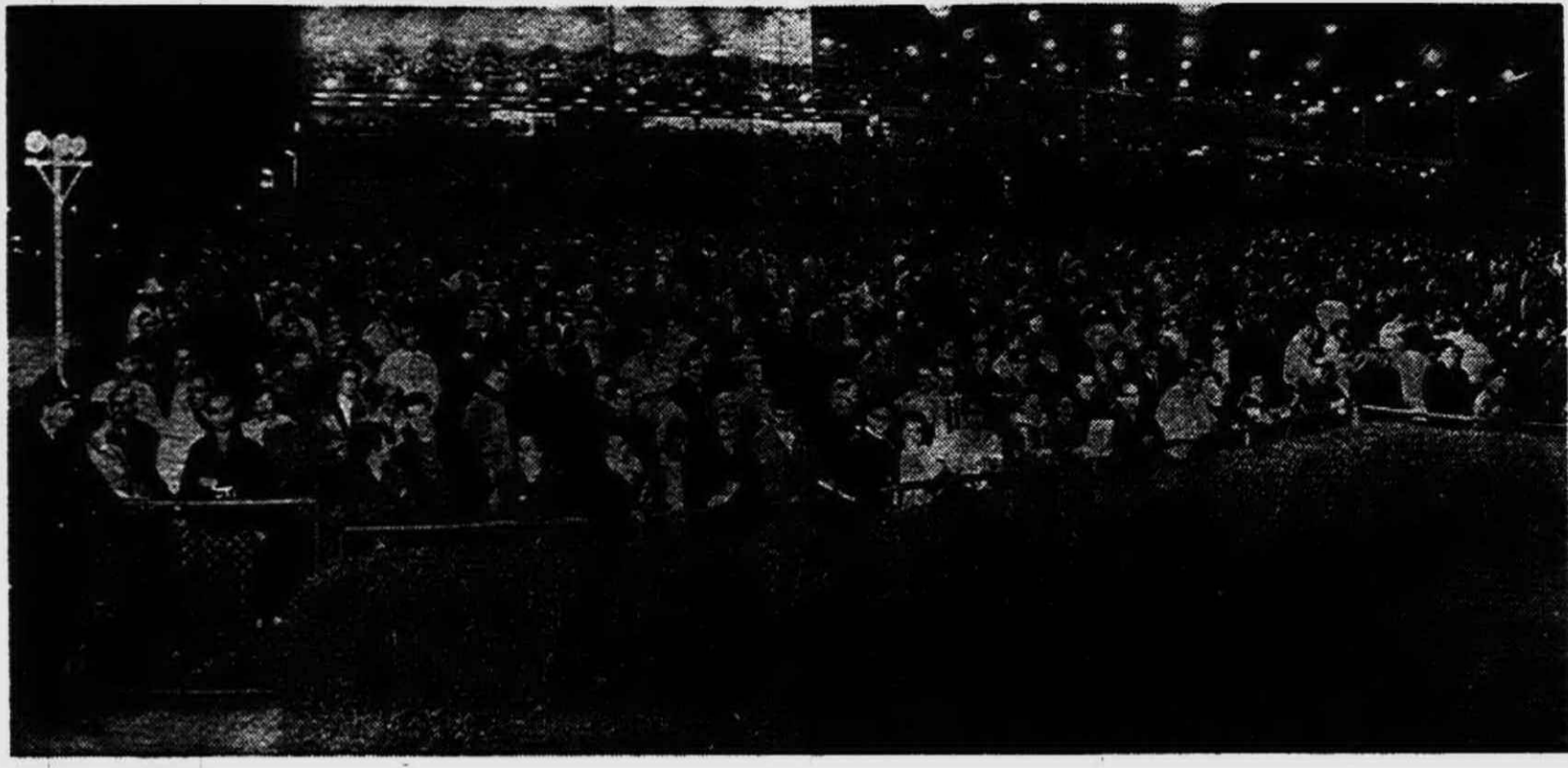

Schostak Attends Meet in Chicago

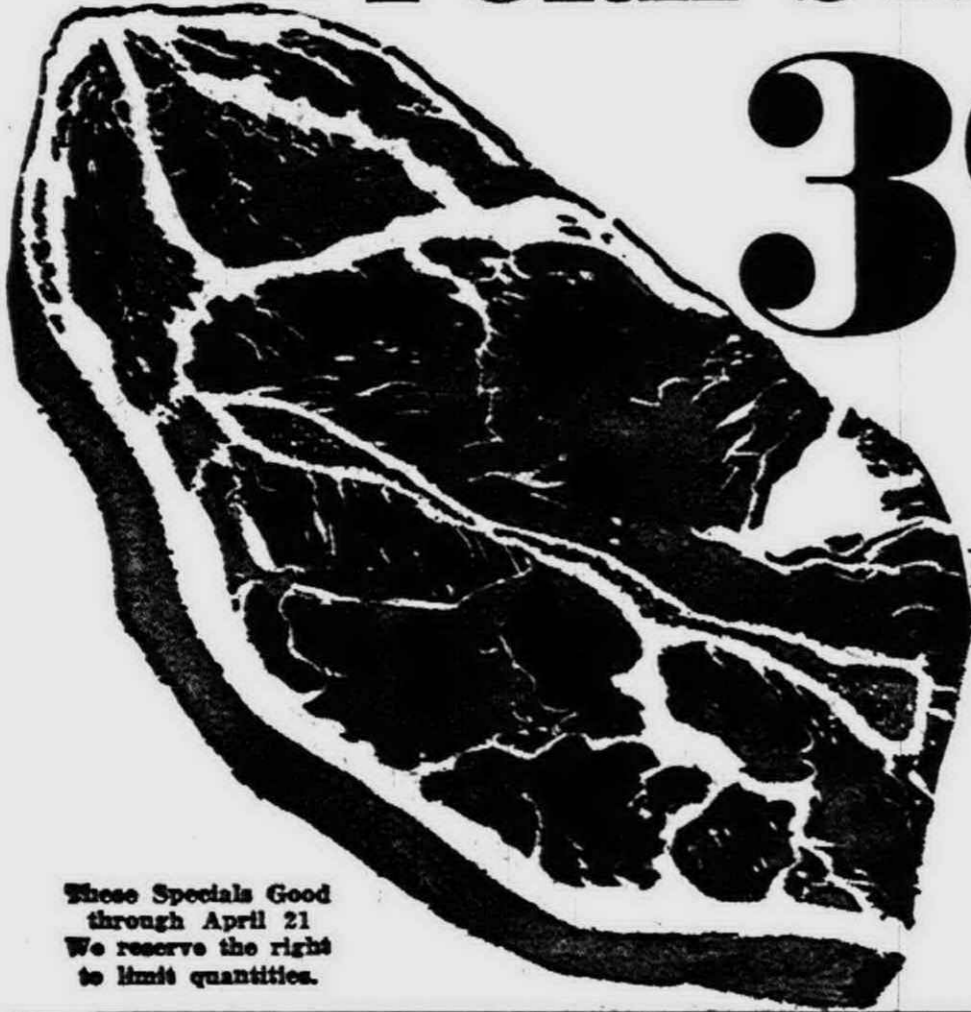
